

# FREQUENTLY ASKED:

## ***Can I attend the AGM if I am not a sponsored delegate?***

Yes, any Métis person or friend of the Métis Nation is welcome to attend the AGM. You do not require to be registered to simply attend or observe.

## ***Can I vote if I have my card but am not registered to attend as a delegate?***

Yes, any MNBC registered Citizen who has their Provincial MNBC Citizenship card can attend and vote at the AGM. You do not have to be a delegate.

## ***When do we register as a voter for the AGM?***

Voter's registration will start on Friday Sept 13, 2019. See [SCHEDULE of EVENTS](#) for details. Delegates at that time will receive their event packages and AGM Kits.

## ***Do I have to reserve tickets for the Reception or Banquet if I am not a registered delegate or otherwise required to attend?***

The Reception on Friday September 13<sup>th</sup> is a Free Event, anyone can attend and all are welcome!

The lunch buffets on Friday and Saturday and Banquet on Saturday night requires a ticket and tickets must be reserved to accurately account for adequate seating and meal preparation no later than Sept 6, 2019. Sponsored delegates and required attendance will receive 1 complimentary banquet ticket. **All guests must reserve their tickets in advance.**

Tickets will be at a cost of \$15.00 for lunch buffets and \$30.00 for banquet/ea. and can be purchased at the time of voting registration ([see schedule](#))

## ***Do I have to reserve tickets to attend the banquet if I am a sponsored delegate?***

Sponsored delegates will receive one (1) complimentary ticket to attend the banquet. Guests of sponsored delegates will require reservations and should be accounted on your registration form when registering for the AGM. *Important: If you have already registered as a sponsored delegate and did not account for or plan to bring additional guests or have a question, please email [traceyt@mNBC.ca](mailto:traceyt@mNBC.ca) to reserve your tickets. Please DO NOT include yourself in the reserved ticket count.*

## ***Can I take advantage of the hotel conference rate if I am not a sponsored delegate?***

Please contact the [Travel Coordinator](#) to request being added to our group block for our conference rate before August 15, 2019. Priority will be given to all sponsored delegates and required attendance.

***Am I eligible for accommodation if I am a sponsored delegate but live close to the venue?***

Unless there is special circumstances, anyone living within 50 km's of the AGM Venue may not be eligible for accommodation. Please contact the [Travel Coordinator](#) to inquire.

***Is there event parking?***

The Civic Centre does not have parking, however, there are a number of areas within walking proximity.
