<p><i>Council Duties:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Attend MWBC Provincial Governance Council and Regional Governance Council meetings as a voting member. ● Read all minutes and reports in advance of meetings to identify errors, omissions and actions that may require follow-up. ● Attend all meetings of the Métis Nation General Assembly, and the MNBC Annual General Meeting as sponsored Participants <p><i>Regional Duties:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Ensure Métis community awareness regarding the purpose, programs, and services for Métis women throughout the Province of British Columbia. ● Participate in issue clarification and resolution. ● Maintain communication with Métis women within their respective regions, keep women informed and up to date on current information, meetings, plans, and goals of the MWBC ● Represent the interests of all Métis women in their respective regions, and advocate on their behalf. ● Support Métis community development and leadership development when the opportunity arises in their respective regions. ● Represent the MWBC’s mandate, guiding principles, goals and objectives to external stakeholders. 	<p><i>Council Duties</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Attend Regional Governance Council meetings and MYBC Provincial Governance Council as voting members. ● Participate in MYBC Strategic planning ● Attend all meetings of Métis Nation General Assembly, and the MNBC Annual General Meeting as Sponsored Participants. <p><i>Regional Duties:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Attend Community and regional events and seek ways to engage with Métis youth locally. ● Represent the interests of Métis youth in their respective region; ● Communicate the voice of Métis youth and advocate on their behalf by bringing observations, concerns, and findings to MYBC Council meetings / the Minister of Youth ● Create awareness of the Ministry of Youth and MNBC programs and events available to Métis youth in BC and promote Métis youth participation in programs and events ● MYBC Council members are compensated to carry out five hours of volunteer service in their region each month, in addition to their Council duties.
