

## 2024 MÉTIS NATION BRITISH COLUMBIA GENERAL ELECTION NOTICE UPDATE

**Public Notice is hereby given to all Métis Citizens of the Métis Nation British Columbia that a General Election will be held September 7th, 2024 from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. PT for the purpose of electing a President, a Vice President, 7 Regional Directors, 7 Regional Youth Representatives, a Chairperson for the Métis Youth, 7 Regional Women's Representatives and a Chairperson of the Métis Women pursuant to and in accordance with the MNBC Electoral Act (2023).**

**PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT ELIGIBLE VOTERS MAY CAST THEIR BALLOT ELECTRONICALLY OR BY MAIL. YOU MAY RETURN YOUR MAIL IN BALLOT PACKAGE BY MAIL OR DEPOSIT IN PERSON AT A DESIGNATED COMMUNITY BALLOT BOX LOCATION. YOU MAY VOTE ONLY ONCE AND FOR ALL BALLOTS AT ANY POLLING OPTION.**

### **ELECTRONIC VOTING OPENS AUGUST 24, 2024**

If you wish to vote online, please visit <https://www.onefeather.ca/nations/mnbc> and follow the instructions provided. ***If you are using OneFeather for the first time*** please have the following information readily available to verify your identity and create your eligible voter profile: personal email address, date of birth, MNBC citizenship/registry number. You can create your eligible voter profile anytime and will receive additional voting instructions and your PIN to vote online when online voting opens.

Mail in ballots will be mailed no later than August 12, 2024, to eligible voters, for whom a current mailing address is known. It may take several days for these voting packages to reach voters – however, if you have not received your mail in ballot voting package by **August 19, 2024**, please contact the Electoral Officer immediately. Your Mail in Ballots must be received by the Chief Electoral Officer no later than 8:00PM PT September 7, 2024. Mail in Ballots received after the close of POLL shall not be counted or recorded.
