**MEETINGS:** Monthly. The Committee may schedule additional meetings as required.

**QUORUM:** Majority of members **VOTING:** Consensus

### **PURPOSE:**

The objective of the Presidential Economic Development Task Force Committee is to create growth, progress, and positive change for the physical, economic, environmental, social, and demographic well being of Métis Citizens in BC, through expanding local and regional economies and increasing employment opportunities.

## The Committee will endeavor to:

- Develop strategic plans for enhancing economic development for MNBC, Chartered Communities, and the Métis Citizens in BC.
- Provide direction on how to support and empower Métis businesses and entrepreneurs through financial support, advocacy, and training.
- Build relationships with federal, provincial, municipal, and other Indigenous governments and agencies to advance economic development and partnerships.

#### **REPORTING MECHANISM:**

The committee will keep high-level notes of all meetings, which will be forwarded to the Board of Directors for review. The committee will make recommendations to the Board of Directors.

## **EXPENSES:**

Meeting expenses must be submitted to the CEO for pre-approval. Individual committee member expenses are reimbursable by MNBC according to approved policy.

**TERMS OF REFERENCE REVIEW:** The Terms of Reference will be revised as appropriate and presented to the Board for review and approval when necessary.
