Senate Composition:

Each of the seven MNBC Regional Governance Council appoints a highly respected individual to represent their judicial needs on a provincial level. These non-political Senators form the Judicial Arm of the MNBC.

Criteria:

As per Article 5.2 of the MNBC [Senate Act](#), please submit:

1. Biography of the Applicant (Relevant information);
2. Proof of Age – must be at least 55 years of age;
3. Copy of your MNBC Citizenship card;
4. A **Criminal Record Check** for volunteers;
5. **Nomination Form** for Senate Vacancy

A nomination must be in writing by a Métis Citizen that holds an MNBC Citizenship card.

Criminal Records Check for MNBC Volunteers – Letter of Request


TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN
