
Reaching Home Program Application Form

The Reaching Home Program supports low-income Métis citizens and self-identified Métis who are homeless, precariously housed or facing housing instability by providing housing loss prevention and housing stabilization services.

Program Services include, but are not limited to:

- ✚ housing crisis interventions and eviction prevention support;
- ✚ assistance with rent and utility arrears;
- ✚ support with housing searches and the rental application process;
- ✚ assistance and support for those exiting homelessness, including damage deposit and first months' rent;
- ✚ assistance with housing set-up costs including basic furnishings and household items;
- ✚ assistance with transportation costs to access emergency accommodations;
- ✚ information on community resources and supports; and
- ✚ information and referrals to other relevant MNBC Programs and resources.

The applicant must:

- ✚ **be experiencing homelessness or at imminent risk of becoming homeless;**
- ✚ **be an MNBC citizen, verified by providing a copy of their MNBC citizenship card, or self-identify as Métis;**
- ✚ **be a resident of BC;**
- ✚ **have a total gross annual household income of \$54,000.00 or less and**
- ✚ **not have assets of more than \$2,500.00 (excluding a personal vehicle).**

Please note: All mandatory fields within the application form MUST be completed, and only fully completed applications with all supporting documents attached will be considered.

Declaration of Truth and Consent:

Declaration of Truth:

- The applicant declares that all the information given in this application form is true and complete.
- The applicant declares that the monthly income declared is factual and true.
- The Métis citizen applicant(s) declares that they have not applied for First Nation status under Bill C31, Bill C-3 or Bill S-3 or any other government legislation. The MNBC Central Registry Office will periodically verify that grant recipients maintain MNBC Citizenship.
- The applicant acknowledges and agrees that the facts given in this application form will be kept and disposed of as required by the [Information Management Act](#).
- The applicant agrees that MNBC may collect data and contact them from time to time for the purpose of conducting any client-related surveys.
- The applicant(s) understands that this application does not obligate MNBC to approve funding.
- All applicants who give personal information to MNBC shall be required to consent to the release of that information to MNBC to comply with the BC [Personal Information Protection Act](#) (PIPA) and [Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act](#) (FIPPA).

 - To confirm household income;
 - To confirm eligibility for the program;
