

Métis Public Health Surveillance Program Information Sharing Agreement

The Province of British Columbia's Ministry of Health and the Métis Nation British Columbia Ministry of Health have taken an important step towards the commitments made through the Métis Nation Relationship Accord in May of 2006.

Métis Nation British Columbia and the Province of British Columbia, through an informed consent process, will match consenting members in the

MNBC's Citizenship Central Registry with key Ministry of Health databases, enabling for the first time creation of health related statistics on the Métis Citizens of British Columbia.

As a result of the Information Sharing Agreement, the two parties can work towards closing the gap on the quality of life between Métis people and other British Columbians.

The strengthening of this relationship is witnessed by






