THIS CHANGE IS BEING MADE FOR A NUMBER OF REASONS INCLUDING EXTENDING THE TIME ALLOWED FOR MAIL IN BALLOTS TO BE PROCESSED AND DELIVERED BY CANADA POST TO THE ELECTORAL OFFICER, OTHER COVID-19 RELATED IMPACTS AND TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THE ELECTORAL ACT. NO OTHER DATE CHANGES PRECEEDING THE NEW ELECTION DATE IN THE 2020 ELECTORAL PROCESSES OR TIMELINE ARE BEING MADE – POST ELECTION DATE DELIVERABLES WILL SHIFT ACCORDINGLY.

All MNBC eligible voters will automatically be sent the appropriate Election related documentation to their last known residential mailing address. It is the MNBC eligible voters' sole responsibility to ensure their correct residential mailing information is on record with MNBC. If an MNBC eligible voter has not received 2020 Election materials in the mail from the Chief Electoral Officer, they should contact the Chief Electoral Officer immediately to confirm their mailing address. All Mail-in Ballots must be received by the Chief Electoral Officer no later than 8:00PM September 21, 2020. Mail-in Ballots received after the close of POLL shall not be counted or recorded.
