Why would we nominate?

To recognize the individuals working in Child Care and the hard work they do and to appreciate the Métis Early Childhood Education Professionals working with children in the community.

Every day, child-care providers and early childhood educators support Métis children in high-quality care environments, where children learn about themselves through Métis cultural infused programming. It is time to nominate those individuals and recognize their dedication to Métis children and families.

Who can we nominate?

Any Early Childhood Education Professionals working with Métis children. Such as those who incorporate Métis culture into daily programming. Inclusive of the following:

Child Care, Strong Start, Preschool, Early Years Drop-in, Early Years cultural programming, Family Child Care, After School Care, or other programming provided by Early Childhood Educators.

Who can make a nomination?

Anyone in the community can nominate any Early Childhood Education Professionals they know who is incorporating Métis culture in programming or who is a Métis Early Childhood Education Professional.
