2021 MÉTIS NATION BRITISH COLUMBIA BY-ELECTION NOTICE

Public Notice is hereby given to all Métis Citizens of the Métis Nation British Columbia that a By-Election will be held December 15, 2021, by Online and Mail in Ballot ONLY for the purpose of electing a President, Regional Women's representatives for Regions 2, 3, 5, and 6, and Regional Youth representatives for Regions 5 and 7, pursuant to and in accordance with the MNBC Electoral Act (2021).

All MNBC eligible voters will automatically be sent a postcard with election related information and instructions to access additional information and documentation relevant to the election processes. It is the MNBC eligible voters' responsibility to ensure their correct residential mailing information is on record with MNBC.

Eligible MNBC electors will be able to vote by mail or electronically in this election. If you wish to vote by mail, you MUST request a mail in ballot voting package directly from the Electoral Officer. Please visit the website links indicated below to request your mail in ballot package or for information on how to vote electronically.

All Mail in Ballots must be received by the Chief Electoral Officer no later than 8:00PM December 15, 2021. Mail in Ballots received after the close of POLL shall not be counted or recorded.
